THE REQUIREMENTS FOR DESIGN OF CONFERENCE MATERIALS

Texts prepared in MS Word (.doc) format that meet the following requirements will be published:

- theses should contain a general statement of the problem, a summary of the main material of the study, conclusions;
- the volume is no more than 3 **full** pages of A4 format; margins: right, left, top, bottom - 2 cm; line spacing - single;
- paragraph 1 - UDC - on the left of the page, 14 points Times New Roman font, normal;
- paragraph 2 - **the title of theses - centered**, 14 points Times New Roman font, bold, all capital letters; with an empty line after the title;
- paragraph 3 - **the surname and initials of the author(s)** - on the right of the page, 14 points Times New Roman font, half bold;
- paragraph 4 - **a scientific degree, a scientific title**, 14 points Times New Roman font, italics;
- paragraph 5 - the name of the organization - on the right of the page, 14 points Times New Roman font, italics;

- theses text - 14 points Times New Roman font, normal;
- after the theses text - an empty line;
- ◆ references - centered, 14 points Times New Roman font, normal;
- pictures in the text of the materials - centered:
Fig. 1. The title centered, 14 points Times New Roman font, italics;
- tables:
Table 1 - on the right of the page; 14 points Times New Roman font, italics;

The name of the table - centered, 14 points Times New Roman font, bold, italics;

- illustrative material should be of high precision and quality. References to illustrations in the text of these are mandatory. All illustrations should be accompanied by illustration titles.

Manuscripts that are not prepared according to the above requirements will not be considered by the organizing committee.

Theses will be published in electronic collections of theses after the materials submitted are acknowledged to be accepted by the organizing committee.
